Q2 Record Review and Outcomes Timeline:

- **July 1st 12th:** Staff housekeeping window for getting your charts in order!
- Week of July 1: QE team will be sending test reports for you to review your data in Apricot for Outcomes reporting. This is the perfect time to review your data while performing housekeeping for record review!
- **July 15th 26th:** Program Record Review Window. We encourage you to complete Record Review in groups or pairs.
- July 29th August 9th: QE Aggregation/Review.
- Week of August 2nd: Program Managers, don't forget to send your non-Apricot reports for Outcomes reporting!
- **August 21st 28th:** Program Manager to complete their assessments of PQI.
- **Week of September 1st:** Outcomes reports sent to program managers.



All Delaware children between birth and 5 are eligible to receive a free book in the mail each month through Dolly Parton's Imagination Library. The program has recently announced a new English/Spanish bilingual option for subscribers.
